NWCOA Bat Standards Certified Course

The NWCOA Bat Standards Certified Course (Part 1) covers bat biology (little brown bat, big brown bat, free-tailed bats, long-eared bat, Indiana bat, and pallid bat). It also covers bat behavior, identification, and morphology. It provides service agreement language for bat removal and guano removal, seasonal restrictions, inspection techniques, equipment, safety, detailed exclusion techniques, job pricing, decontamination techniques, rabies, bat handling, updated white-nose syndrome information, and much more. This course is a one-day, classroom style training course. This course is a prerequisite to the NWCOA Certified Structural Bat Management Professional Course (Part 2). The NWCOA Bat Standards Certified Course (Part 1) has replaced the NWCOA Bat Standards Compliant Course.

Zoonotic diseases are infectious conditions transmitted by animals to people. People who work with wildlife need to be familiar with the more common zoonoses and understand their risk factors and routes of transmission. Zoonotic diseases are often highly contagious and yet not always easily diagnosed, which heightens the need for consistent and committed prevention efforts and a solid understanding of disinfection principles.

This 1-day course explores all of these and other critical aspects to clarify and strengthen participants' understanding and knowledge related to zoonotic disease. Participants will learn about the major groups of pathogens, gain familiarity with a variety of diseases - including several newly discovered diseases - and gain insights into the science and benefits surrounding disinfection.

This course will teach you what you wish you didn't have to know, but absolutely must. Upon successful completion of this course and a test, the WCO will receive a certificate of completion, use of the logo mark and become a NWCOA Certified Zoonotic Disease Professional.
